Swindon Arts Centre is a 212-seat entertainment venue located in the Old Town area of Swindon. It was opened officially on 1st September 1956, by The Worshipful the Mayor, Alderman N V Toze and Dr. Wyn Griffith, vice-chairman of the Arts Council of Great Britain.

The venue hosts a varied programme of entertainment all year round, made up of both professional and amateur productions.
